Early in the last century, Thomas Say described species from the Carolinas, and in the middle 1800 s Professor L. R. Gibbes, who maintained a private collection in Charleston, S.C., described species from the Carolinas. William Stimpson (1860b), who visited Beaufort, N.C., in company with T. N. Gill, gave a list of 38 species of decapod crustaceans which he collected there. Elliott Cones (1871), at that time an Army surgeon stationed at Fort Macon, N.C., recorded 27 species of decapods from the Beaufort area, 8 of which were additions to Stimpson s list. Seven years later, Cones and Yarrow (1878) gave a list of six species, two of which had not appeared previously. An appendix to the same paper by J. S. Kingsley included 51 species from the Beaufort area, and 3 of these were additions to the fauna. A year later, Kingsley (1870) contributed eight more...
