George Perrot, founder of the chair of Classical Archaeology in the French Academy and, with his collaborator Chas. Chipiez, author of the well-known volumes of *Ancient Art*. In 1891 M. Perrot submitted to the school authorities of France a scheme, forthwith adopted and put into operation, by which as compensation for the withdrawal of Greek and Latin from a section of the curriculum, three hours weekly were to be divided between the history of civilization and the history of art, This applied only to the division called the First Modern and not too students preparing for a University course. The experiment has covered eight years and in spite of many drawbacks, has been of such value that M. Perrot insists, in justice to students of the so-called Classical Course, that it be extended to them that these lads destined for liberal careers and with years of training...
